LET'S TALK

Location

Locations can make or break a session. That's a lot of pressure, so how do you determine the best spot? Below are the top questions to consider when picking a spot worthy for your session time

Do I have a style/theme/vibe in mind?

Is there a location that is particularly important to me? (first date, proposals, go-to spot)

Seasonally, am I ok with warm/cold temperatures?

ON THE WATER

Session with a canoe, photos by the shore, or waterfall explorations

FARM & COUNTRY

Apple picking, pumpkin patching, smoke colors, woodland themes

CITYSCAPE

Cherry blossom festival, downtown historic cities, flowy dresses & old architecture

PARK

Picnics, dog walking, flower meadows, and gardens

MOUNTAINS

Vast views, rocky structures, skyscapes

HOME

Comfy cozy vibes, pillow forts, kitchen floors, intimate sessions

- Match the style to the location
- & an accent color that compliment each other
- Soft, neutral tones they bring attention to your face
- Styles that flatter your figure & are comfortable
- If wearing heels, bring an extra pair of comfy shoes along
- Add interest with layers and statement pieces such as outfits that flow or have texture
- Dress up!





WHAT TO AVOID

Avoid too many

- patterns this can be distracting

 Avoid dressing everyone in the same
 - exact outfit.
 Coordinate, don't
 match
- Avoid large logos
- Don't forget to check weather! Comfort is a key factor & a strapless dress in December is not going to feel great
- Avoid baseball caps or anything that will take away from seeing your face clearly
- Avoid matching
 T-shirts and jeans, I
 know it seems an easy
 route, but we want this
 session to be more
 than a casual session





Should I wear makeup?

Makeup can enhance your features for the camera, and something I do recommend. If you don't want to mess with it yourself, I have a list of professionals I highly suggest. If you're getting married and have a stylist picked out, talk to them about a trial run for your wedding day- that way you can test out styles.

Should I consider props?

If you're looking to add a little extra to your session, I have some recommendations for you! Flowers, balloons, blankets, hats, champagne, colored smoke, and confetti can be a fun addition to any session.

Any tips for sessions with kids?

Kids have a much shorter attention span, which is why I tailor my family sessions accordingly. Bring snacks, their favorite book or stuffed animal and we will roll with the moods. My favorite photographs of children will always be the candid ones.
